In the past year, ACE provided top quality medical and surgical eye care to the uninsured and underinsured at our downtown Bakersfield Clinic. ACE also provided 405 kids in Kern County with free eye exams and free eyeglasses through a partnership with OneSight. CBVI provided blind field service training and recreational program services for 130 blind and visually impaired individuals in our community.

Fortunately, with your help, the

funds raised at our event this year will remove barriers for our friends and neighbors who are uninsured, underinsured, and blind or visually impaired by effectively providing them with a wide range of access to services such as comprehensive eye exams, eye surgeries, and independent living programs to address their needs so that they may continue to achieve their goals, live independently, and live fulfilled lives!



HONORING SENATOR ANDY VIDAK

The Most Fascinating Person of 2014



This year, Center for the Blind and Visually Impaired and Advanced Center for Eyecare is proud to honor Senator Andy Vidak as the "Most Fascinating Person of 2014" for his commitment to eye care for the underserved population in Kern County and our State. Many of the communities that Senator Andy Vidak represents suffer from extreme poverty and some of the highest unemployment rates in the State and the Country. Most of these individuals have never seen an eye doctor before nor have the ability to purchase glasses for their children or themselves to see clearly in the world in which they live. Andy understands that a simple pair of glasses can change a child's or adult's life to succeed in school and/or the workplace.

In August 2014, Andy's commitment to eye care for the underserved was demonstrated through his passion to bring two mobile vision van clinics named "Mobile Eyes to the Valley" to the Kern and Fresno County areas through a partnership with VSP.

As a result of his efforts, 57 people received a comprehensive eye exam and, if needed, a pair of glasses. Out of the 57 examined, 52 people needing glasses were able to select from a top quality assortment of frames, with most patients receiving their new glasses immediately after their eye exam. Another 80 people who couldn't be served on clinic days (because of time limitations) received vouchers to get a free eye exam and a pair of glasses from local optometrists at a

later date. Andy's commitment to supporting eye care in Kern County, along with many other accomplishments this year, make him the "Most Fascinating Person of 2014."
